New Carrier Options

Both FedEx and UPS have new default printing options available under the Carrier Editor. The following FedEx options are available:

- Image Type: This updates what kind of image comes back from the request.
- Label Stock: This updates the size of the image that FedEx returns from the requests.
- Printing Orientation: This updates where printing starts on the label.

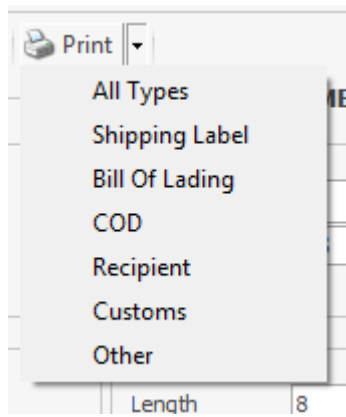
