NAFTA Certificate of Origin

The NAFTA Certificate of Origin is used within North America to determine if imported goods are eligible for reduced or eliminated duty as part of the North American Free Trade Agreement. Once the *NAFTA Certificate of Origin* security is enabled, you will be able to select the report in Report Manager or in the print menu.
